ORDER

Hon'ble Delhi High Court in W.P. No. 669/2021- Sahara Credit Cooperative Society Ltd., W.P. No. 670/2021- Saharayn Universal Multipurpose Society Ltd., & W.P. No. 817/2021- Humara India Credit Cooperative Society Ltd., vs. Union of India has passed an Order dated 22.03.2022. In compliance of the order, claims received in the office of the Central Registrar of Cooperative Societies (CRCS) and through court intervention applications are being sent to the Nodal Officer/Managing Director of the societies concerned for verification and settlement in batches after digitisation. This order is in respect of claims in the sixth batch sent to **Sahara Credit Cooperative Society Ltd.**, hereinafter, referred to as the Society.

2. Whereas, the sixth batch was sent vide e-mail dated 28.04.2022 with a direction to reply within a week in the prescribed format after due verification. Since, the requisite details were not received in time, a reminder letter was sent on 06.05.2022 via e-mail to the designated nodal officer of the above Society to submit reply within 7 days. But, so far no reply from the society on the claims of **Batch-VI** has been received in this office.

3. The Hon'ble High Court in its Order dated 22.03.2022 has ordered that in case the petitioners fail or refuse to provide any information called for, the Central Registrar shall be entitled to pass orders in the absence of the petitioners. Since in this case no reply has been received from the Society despite constant follow up, therefore, the Society is directed to make payment to 7245 claims of the Batch-VI within two weeks of this order as per the timelines stipulated by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in its order dated 22.03.2022. It is also directed to upload the proof of payment by the due date.

ORDER

Hon'ble Delhi High Court in W.P. No. 669/2021- Sahara Credit Cooperative Society Ltd., W.P. No. 670/2021- Saharayn Universal Multipurpose Society Ltd., & W.P. No. 817/2021- Humara India Credit Cooperative Society Ltd., vs. Union of India has passed an Order dated 22.03.2022. In compliance of the order, claims received in the office of the Central Registrar of Cooperative Societies (CRCS) and through court intervention applications are being sent to the Nodal Officer/Managing Director of the societies concerned for verification and settlement in batches after digitisation. This order is in respect of claims in the seventh batch sent to **Sahara Credit Cooperative Society Ltd.**, hereinafter, referred to as the Society.

2. Whereas, the seventh batch was sent vide e-mail dated 29.04.2022 with a direction to reply within a week in the prescribed format after due verification. Since, the requisite details were not received in time, a reminder letter was sent on 06.05.2022 via e-mail to the designated nodal officer of the above Society to submit reply within 7 days. But, so far no reply from the society on the claims of **Batch-VII** has been received in this office.

3. The Hon'ble High Court in its Order dated 22.03.2022 has ordered that in case the petitioners fail or refuse to provide any information called for, the Central Registrar shall be entitled to pass orders in the absence of the petitioners. Since in this case no reply has been received from the Society despite constant follow up, therefore, the Society is directed to make payment to 788 claims (filed before the Hon'ble Court by way of intervention applications) of the Batch-VII within two weeks of this order as per the timelines stipulated by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in its order dated 22.03.2022. It is also directed to upload the proof of payment by the due date.
