Notice

Chief Promoter, RBS Agro Multi State Cooperative Society Ltd., Survey No. 80/2, Satpute Chowk, Nagar Pune Road, Bhushan Nagar, Kedgaon, Ahmednagar-414005, Maharashtra, has submitted a proposal for registration of a multi-State cooperative society under the provisions of Multi-State Cooperative Societies (MSCS) Act, 2002. On scrutiny, the following deficiencies have been observed in the proposal :-


- a) The objectives are vast in Form No. 1 and in bye-law No. 5. At the time of registration, the objectives are to be limited to certain extent since the bye-laws are amendable as and when the need arises from time to time based on the requirement.
- b) In form No. 1, the reasons given by the society for its registration under MSCS Act, 2002 do not seem to be on valid ground and it can be registered under State Act.
- c) In bye-law No. 11, the proviso as required u/s 25(4) of the Act has not been provided.
- d) Bye-law No. 23(1) is not framed properly in consonance with the provision of section 37(1) of Act.
- e) The provision made in bye-law No. 34(v) is not required to be provided in bye-laws.
- f) In bye-law No. 46 relating to the powers and functions of Chief Executive, the provision as required u/s 52 (k) has not been provided.
- g) Bye-law No. 48(c) is not framed properly in consonance with the provision of section 63 of the Act.
- h) Bye-law No. 53(a) is not framed properly in consonance with the provision of section 70 of the Act.
- i) Project report is not satisfactory. It appears that it is copied from some other project. Further, in the project report, no source of income has been provided. The detailed breakup for the income and expenditure has not been provided.
- j) In the membership lists of Maharashtra and Karnataka, it appears that few persons have signed in many places. Further, in the membership lists, full addresses of the members have not been provided as required under form 1 of the MSCS Act, 2002.
- k) ID proofs of some members at S.No.6,10,31,42,48,49,51 of the State of Maharashtra and ID proofs of the members at S.No.1,4,5,11,14 of Karnataka do not match with the name mentioned in their respective membership list.

- l) Provision relating to "Maximum Borrowing Limit" as per section 67 of the Act has not been incorporated in the bye-laws.
- m) Signature of the Chief Promoter does not match with signature given the membership list of the State of Maharashtra.
- n) There is overwriting of signature of the Chief Promoter in the Promoter List.

2. In view of the above deficiencies, you are hereby called upon to show cause as to why the registration of the above proposed society in the name of **RBS Agro Multi State Cooperative Society Ltd., Survey No. 80/2, Satpute Chowk, Nagar Pune Road, Bhushan Nagar, Kedgaon, Ahmednagar-414005, Maharashtra**, under the Multi-State Cooperative Societies Act, 2002 and the rules made thereunder shall not be refused. The Chief promoter of the society or in his absence any promoter member authorized by him is called upon to appear before the Central Registrar of Cooperative Societies on 22/02/2016 at 9.45 A.M. in Room No. 224, Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi.

3. If none appears for hearing, it would be presumed that you have nothing to say in the matter and accordingly, appropriate order shall be passed as ex-parte.
