Chief Promoter, Green Mark Multi State Agro Co-operative Society Limited, Ground Floor, Part of Khasra No. 201 of Property Bearing No. C-1/31, Situated at Jasola Village Extension, New Delhi – 110025 has submitted a proposal for registration of a multi-State cooperative society under the provisions of Multi-State Cooperative Societies (MSCS) Act, 2002. On scrutiny, the following deficiencies have been observed in the proposal :-

- The objectives & functions proposed in Form No. I and in bye-law No. 5 are not achievable by the society and the same are some of the objectives of the government to uplift the entire farming community.
- ii) Bye-law No. 8 is not framed properly.
- iii) In bye-law No. 11, the proviso as required u/s 25(4) has not been provided.
- iv) Bye-law No. 21(1) is not consistent with the provision of section 37(1) of the MSCS Act, 2002.
- v) The heading of bye-law No. 43 relating to Annual General Body meeting is not clear.
- vi) Bye-law No. 61(a) is not framed properly in consonance with provision of section 70 of the Act.
- Limitation period for disputes are given in two bye-laws i.e. in 67(a) & 68 and it should be provided only in one place.
- viii) Bank certificate furnished along with the proposal is April 2015 and whereas, latest certificate has to be enclosed along with the proposal.
- ix) Project report is not satisfactory. The detailed break up for income & expenditure has not been provided. Further, the project report is not supported by facts and figures which have been narrated in the viability report. It appears that the project has been copied from some other proposal and not prepared on real-time basis as required for the society.
- x) Full address of members in the membership lists of Uttar Pradesh & Delhi are not provided as required under Form I, Column 5 against some of the members. Further, some of the signatures appear to be signed by a few persons in the membership list of Uttar Pradesh.
- As per the membership list, some of the members have contributed 94 times more than the other members for which reasons cannot given since one member one vote principle in cooperatives.

2. In view of the above deficiencies, you are hereby called upon to show cause as to why the registration of the above proposed society in the name of Green Mark Multi State Agro Co-operative Society Limited, Ground Floor, Part of Khasra No. 201 of Property Bearing No. C-1/31, Situated at Jasola Village Extension, New Delhi – 110025 under the Multi-State Cooperative Societies Act, 2002 and the rules made thereunder shall not be refused. The Chief promoter of the society or in his absence any promoter member authorized by him is called upon to appear before the Central Registrar of Cooperative Societies on 22|01|2016 at 9-60 A.M. in Room No. 224, Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi.

3. If none appears for hearing, it would be presumed that you have nothing to say in the matter and accordingly, appropriate order shall be passed as ex-parte.
